### Successful Damage Assessment in 2 Gram Panchayats

The CYSD DANA assessment team has completed damage assessments in 5 villages under the Gram Panchayats of Satabhaya and Gupti. The villages assessed so far are Satabhaya, Bagapatia, Charigharia, Gupti, and Banabiharipur.

### Key Findings

The assessment team found that many houses in these villages were severely damaged, and others were partially damaged.

- Satabhaya was significantly affected by DANA, with about 129 households with severe damage and 125 with partial damage. Gupti had 10 cases of severe household damage and 45 partial household damage.
- After interacting with the Sarpanches, it was found that about 175 hectares of paddy land in these 2 GPs had extensive damage.
- At present, the waterlogging has been cleared in these GPs, however, the large deposits of silt in the villages proves to be a problem.

### Government Initiatives

- **Land and Crop Loss Assistance:** Farmers receive up to ₹18,000 per hectare for de-silting and ₹47,000 per hectare for land loss due to landslides, avalanches, or river changes, with minimum assistance levels set to support small and marginal farmers.
- **Input Subsidy for Crop Loss (33% and Above):** Subsidies are provided based on crop type and irrigation, with ₹8,500 per hectare for rainfed crops, ₹17,000 for irrigated areas, and up to ₹22,500 for perennial and agro-forestry crops.
- **Special Support for Sericulture:** Farmers engaged in sericulture receive targeted subsidies ranging from ₹6,000 to ₹7,500 per hectare depending on the silkworm type, ensuring support for silk production.
- **Input Subsidy for Larger Landholdings:** Farmers with over 2 hectares are eligible for subsidies of ₹8,500 per hectare in rainfed areas, ₹17,000 in irrigated areas, and ₹22,500 for perennial and agro-forestry crops.

### Other Perceived Requirements

Ground level assessment in the GPs has revealed the need for additional requirements like hygiene kits, vegetable seeds, support for house-repair, and other essential household equipment.
