

Floods 2020 !!

Odisha Floods 2020 has so far claimed 22 human lives. A total of 3256 villages under 896 gram panchayats in 112 blocks were hit due to the massive flood resulting in the wake of incessant rainfall due to back to back low pressures in the Bay of Bengal.

While the flood has affected around 1.4 million people across 20 districts of the state, Jajpur district has been the worst hit. In Bari block, 13 out of the 29 flood affected panchayats are still fighting to stay afloat in this terrible flood situation. Over 75, 737 hectares of farmland got submerged and sand-cast in the floodwater



In response to Odisha Floods 2020, CYSD has started its relief operation in Bari block of Jajpur district in association with like minded civil society/humanitarian organisations like, Abhijan and Amrut Global Network and Humanitarian Aid International.

CYSD has set up three Nodes to initiate relief operations in Bari block of the district i.e.

- i) Malli Village of Ratnagari,
- 2) Gaama village of Indupur and
- 3) Ramadevi Ashram at Bari



CYSD's Response to Floods 2020

- 100+ NSS & NYP volunteers mobilised who are engaged in 3 Nodes set up in Bari Block.
- 30 Volunteers oriented to conduct sanitation drive at identified villages.
- Sanitation Drive cleaning and bleaching of village lanes, water resource and dug wells carried out in Malasahi village of Raujari GP under Bariblock. This drive benefited around 130 households in the village.
- 196 worst affected households in Makalapada village of Mahakalpada GP received dry food (Chuda, Gur & Biscuit)
- Cooked food distributed 2420 people engaged in repairing their own houses in the villages of Mandari, Meduakul, Barhampur, Shukala and Benjarapur under the GPs of Mandari, Chanpur and Serapur.
- 200 families identified who have not received any support from any quarter.
- Community owned temple premises /religious places also got cleaned leading to huge satisfaction of the villagers.
- Like minded NGOs have been identified in Jajpur district and Bari block to deepen the relief and rehabilitation activities in close coordination with the district administration.





Drone-based Rapid Damage Assessment

Jajpur district of Odisha has experienced unprecedented floods causing huge damage to lives and livelihoods of people. CYSD together with Humanitarian Aid International (HAI) has deployed a drone team for assessment of the affected areas in collaboration with ODRAF team and district administration. This assessment would help planning the immediate relief and recovery support required by the affected population. On Sept. Drone 5th using rapid assessment was conducted in three villages of Kaipada, Anyasipur, etc. in Bari block.



Highlights

Flood Package declared by Chief Minister:

- Cooked/dry food will be provided to the people at shelter homes 50 K.G rice and Rs.500 to families severely affected by flood.
- Polythene sheets to be given to affected households to cover damage houses.
- Assistance for clothing and utensils House damage assistance to be given after assessment of damage within 15 days.
- Assistance to be disbursed within next 7 days
- Cattle feed assistance to be given to dairy farmers
- Exemption of fees for vaccination and treatment of animals in affected areas.
- Free animal check up camps in affected areas
- Assistance to be provided as per SDRF norms
